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Summary: Power banks must be carried on your person or in your carry-on luggage. Storing them in overhead bins is prohibited.

Are power banks allowed in carry-on luggage in Korea?

Airlines, both Korean and foreign, have implemented similar rules to ensure passenger safety: Up to 100Wh: Allowed in carry-on luggage without prior approval. 100Wh to 160Wh: Allowed in carry-on luggage with airline approval. Above 160Wh: Prohibited. Power banks must be carried on your person or in your carry-on luggage.

What are South Korea's new power banks rules?

South Korea is instituting new rules on what type of power banks passengers can bring on board airplanes from March 1, 2025. These new rules are due to an Air Busan plane catching fire in late January at the Busan Airport, although the cause of the incident has not been confirmed yet.

Do you need a power bank in Yonhap?

Yonhap Starting March 1, passengers flying with Korean-owned airlines will be required to either keep their power banks in protective pouches or transparent plastic bags, or cover the connectors with insulating tape.

How many power banks can a passenger bring on a flight?

Passengers are also not allowed to charge power banks during flights, and the number of power banks each passenger can bring on board is limited to five. Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, and Transport & Korea Transportation Safety Authority released the following guidelines: 1. Spare Battery Carrying Limits

Can you carry a power bank on a flight?

Power banks must be carried on your person or in your carry-on luggage. Storing them in overhead bins is prohibited. Charging power banks during the flight is prohibited. As I prepare for my trip from Singapore to Seoul, I've made sure to check the capacity of my power bank.

Can a passenger check in a power bank on a plane?

Passengers are not allowed to check in power banks, and they are not allowed to be kept inside luggage in overhead compartments. Passengers are also not allowed to charge power banks during flights, and the number of power banks each passenger can bring on board is limited to five.
