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Title: Can outdoor power supplies be connected in parallel

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Summary: Designers connect power supplies in parallel to obtain a total output current greater than that available from one individual supply as well as to provide redundancy, enhance reliability, avoid PCB thermal issues and boost system efficiency.

What is a parallel power supply?

Parallel power supplies refer to a configuration where multiple DC power supplies are connected in parallel to increase total output current. Each power supply shares the current load, ensuring that no single unit is overloaded. Higher Current Output - Allows for increased power delivery by combining the output of multiple units.

Can power supplies be connected together for parallel operation?

The power supplies can be connected together for parallel operation to increase the output current. See Figure 1 below. To achieve this, it is important that the output voltages of both power supplies must be within 25mV difference of each other.

Can a DC power supply be connected in parallel?

DC power supplies may be connected in parallel for either increased power output or improved redundancy. When connected in parallel, output current will be 2X of that of one individual power supply.

Is it possible to parallelize a power supply?

Typically, identical supplies are used when configuring them in parallel, given the challenges associated with efficiently aligning different power supply configurations. Nonetheless, it is feasible to parallelize supplies with matching output voltages while having non-matching maximum output currents.

Can power supplies be connected in series?

Power supplies can be connected in series to increase the output voltage as shown in Figure 5. Only power supply from the same product series and with same rated output current should be used. The maximum load current should not exceed the smallest rated output current, when selecting power supplies with different current ratings.

What happens when a supply is connected in parallel?

As mentioned previously, when connecting the outputs of supplies in parallel, each supply provides the required voltage, and the load current is shared between the supplies.
