RED or BROWN = Phase, Hot or Line, (L) 2. BLACK or SKY BLUE = Neutral (N) 3. GREEN or GREEN / YELLOW = Earth Conductor "Protective earth".

What is the color code for DC wiring?

The color code for DC wiring typically assigns specific colors to the positive and negative wires, as well as any additional wires that may be present. In most cases, the positive wire is red, while the negative wire is black.

What color is a DC wire?

Here are the basic color code requirements for DC wires as per NEC Article 250: Red: Used for the positive (+) wire in nearly all DC systems (battery, solar, automotive, electronics). In Europe, as per IEC standards, positive wire is Brown. Black: Used for the negative (-) wire in all DC systems, returns current to the power source.

Wiring color codes vary by region and are designed to meet local standards and regulations for AC (Alternating Current) single-phase, AC three-phase, and DC (Direct Current) systems. Notable standards include: The NEC (National Electrical Code) in the United States. The CEC (Canadian Electrical Code) in Canada.
