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Will the Cook Islands convert to solar energy in 2022?

At the 2022 United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP27) it was reported that the Cook Islands has converted 13 of its 15 islands to solar energy and set a target of 2025 for the remaining two. The target was revised to 2030 in September last year by director of Renewable Energy Development, Tangi Tereapii.

How much energy does the Cook Islands use?

The Cook Islands is a net importer of energy, in the form of petroleum products. Total energy consumption was 1,677,278,000 BTU (1.77 TJ) in 2017, of which 811,000,000 (0.86 TJ) was in the form of oil. In 2012 47% of imported oil was used in the transport sector, 30% in aviation, and 27% for electricity generation.

Does Rarotonga have solar power?

The Cook Islands Electricity Sector All inhabited islands of the Cook Islands currently have centralised power supplies that have historically been powered by diesel generators. Since around 2011, increasing solar PV generation on Rarotonga has changed this situation.

How was electricity produced in the Cook Islands?

Electricity in the Cook Islands was historically produced by diesel generators on each island. Fuel was imported from Auckland and required long sea voyages to get to the northern atolls, resulting in high costs and occasional supply disruptions.
