

Title: Does a generator set need a substation

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Summary: Generating substations step up the voltage from the generator's lower voltage to a higher voltage which is more economical for transmitting electric power over longer distances with less power losses caused by the impedance of transmission lines.

Do substations have generators?

Substations do not (usually) have generators, although a power plant may have a substation nearby. A typical substation will contain line termination structures, high-voltage switchgear, one or more power transformers, low voltage switchgear, surge protection, controls, grounding (earthing) system, and metering.

How a substation is used in a power plant?

Substation are used to transform the voltage with power transformer. From low voltage to high voltage at the power plant with breaker and control system to be able to transport the energy, and other substation at the arrival to decrease the voltage.

Why is it necessary to build a substation?

Substations are necessary because they have capacitor banks connected to all three phases of the lines to ease the power flow and improve the power factor of the electrical system. There are several other reasons for building a substation, but these are the most important ones.

What are the components of a substation?

A typical substation will contain line termination structures, high-voltage switchgear, one or more power transformers, low voltage switchgear, surge protection, controls, grounding (earthing) system, and metering. Other devices such as power factor correction capacitors and voltage regulators may also be located at a substation.

What is an electric power substation?
