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Title: Dublin Energy Storage Container Investment Project

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Summary: It is located at Poolbeg Energy Hub, where ESB - around 95% owned by the Irish state with the remaining stake held by its employees - is planning to deploy a combination of clean energy technologies, including offshore wind, hydrogen, and battery storage, over the coming decade.

Which energy companies are bringing a battery storage plant to Ireland?

Last October, Siemens Energy shared plans to bring a hybrid grid stabilisation and battery storage plant to Ireland. The large-scale battery storage system will have a capacity of around 160MWh. Last July, Neoen Renewables Ireland Ltd, a French renewable energy company, announced a 149.6MW BESS on an 8.5ac site near Portarlinton, Laois.

Why is ESB launching a new battery plant in Dublin?

Wednesday, 7th February 2024 Dublin, Ireland - ESB has today opened a major battery plant at its Poolbeg site in Dublin which will add 75MW (150MWh) of fast-acting energy storage to help provide grid stability and deliver more renewables on Ireland's electricity system.

Which ESB site is the largest in Ireland?

According to the Dublin-based, state-owned energy company, the battery energy storage system (BESS) is currently the largest site of its kind in commercial operation in Ireland. The site is the latest in ESB's project pipeline, consisting of sites in Dublin and Cork, representing an investment of up to EUR300 million (\$323 million).

How much energy storage does Ireland have?

Image: ESB. ESB Networks has announced that Ireland's electricity grid now has 1GW of energy storage available from different energy storage assets. This figure includes 731.5MW of battery energy storage system (BESS) projects and 292MW from Turlough Hill pumped storage power station - which is celebrating its 50th anniversary this year.

Which energy projects are being rolled out in Ireland?

The 20MW BESS will be co-located with Statkraft's 55.8MW Cushaling Wind Farm, which is under construction. Many BESS projects are set to be rolled out at pace. Last October, Siemens Energy shared plans to bring a hybrid grid stabilisation and battery storage plant to Ireland.

How many battery storage projects are there in Ireland?

More currently, according to our colleagues at Solar Media Market Research, which produces the Republic of Ireland Battery Storage Project Database Report, there are now 545MW and 609MWh of utility-scale BESS projects already operational in the Republic of Ireland.
