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What is the optical backbone project in China?

In addition, during 1995-2000 the Chinese Ministry of Broadcast, Films and Television carried out a national optical cable backbone project which implemented a 3-Vertical & 3-Horizontal architecture to bridge the 26 provincial optical CATV centers with 48,000 km optical cable and multi-wavelength SDH digital transmission systems.

How many optical fiber vendors are there in China?

Now there are 20 vendors producing optical fiber and also optical cable in China among which over 10 enterprises produce optical preform, fiber and cable as a whole.

How will optical transmission evolve in China's backbone network?

(1) Optical transmission in backbone network will evolve to higher bandwidth and larger capacity in P bit level. China's optical transport network has entered the era of all-optical network 2.0, from full- optical fiber network to full-optical automatic scheduling. The backbone network has been upgrading from 100G to 200G or higher.
