Does Oceania have solar energy?

The preceding maps of Solar radiation (Solargis) and Wind energy (Global Wind Atlas) show that Oceania is able to be roughly split into regions close to the Equator and those farther away with different amounts of Solar radiation and ranges of Mean Wind Speeds. Solar Power appears to be the most significant source of Renewable Energy at this time.

What is the latitude of Oceania?

Oceania ranges from 28 degrees north latitude to 55 degrees south latitude. The islands include continental islands, high islands (volcanic), coral reefs, and uplifted coral platforms.

How many islands are in Oceania?

Oceania (including Melanesia, Micronesia, and Polynesia) has ~10,000 islands with about 12 million inhabitants (excluding Australia) with many Indigenous cultures. Oceania ranges from 28 degrees north latitude to 55 degrees south latitude.

How is energy used in the Pacific?

Transport by land and sea is a large proportion of energy use in the Pacific (see Section 2.2), and all of it is currently fuelled by petroleum products. Making ethanol from sugar cane is a very well established process, not least for rum.
