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How much wattage do I need for my appliances?

The actual wattage required for your appliances may differ from those listed. Check the nameplate on the appliance to determine the actual wattage required. * Appliances and tools with induction motors (marked * in tables) may require from 3 to 7 times the listed wattage when starting.

What wattage should I use?

Use the total wattage, plus 20%, as your minimum power requirement. Note: The wattage's given below are estimates. The actual wattage required for your appliances may differ from those listed. Check the nameplate on the appliance to determine the actual wattage required.
