Household solar panel systems are usually up to 4kWp in size. That stands for kilowatt 'peak' output - ie at its most efficient, the system will produce that many kilowatts per hour (kWh).

A 400-watt solar panel will produce anywhere from 1.20 to 1.80 kWh per day (at 4-6 peak sun hours locations). The biggest 700-watt solar panel will produce anywhere from 2.10 to 3.15 kWh per day (at 4-6 peak sun hours locations). Let's have a look at solar systems as well:
