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What legislation governs the telecoms sector in Italy?

The primary legislation governing the telecoms sector in Italy is D.lgs. No. 259/2003, the Electronic Communications Code ('Codice delle Comunicazioni Elettroniche', 'CCE'), as recently reshaped by the D.Lgs. No. 207/2021, which implemented Directive EU 2018/1972 establishing the European Electronic Communications Code.

What does the Department of telecommunications (Comunicazioni) do?

The Department of Telecommunications (Comunicazioni) within the Ministry of Enterprises and Made in Italy (Ministero delle Imprese e del Made in Italy) is responsible for planning and implementing Italy's national digital connectivity plan and telecommunications infrastructures.
