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Is Mauritania leading West Africa's green energy transition?

As Mauritania leads in west Africa's green energy transition, significant investment is being made in hydrogen, solar and wind energy developments.

Who owns Mauritania's electricity plant?

Completed in 2017, the \$53 million plant is run by the national electricity company, Societe Mauritanienne d'Electricite (Somelec), and has seen ongoing works since its inauguration by (then) President Mohamed Ould Abdel Aziz, removing an estimated 57,000 tonnes of CO₂ per annum and supplying 10% of Mauritania's net energy production.

Does Mauritania have solar?

TOUJOUNINE - Solar Averaging seven days of rain a year, Mauritania's climate is ideal for solar and the country's first major development in the sector did not disappoint in this regard with 54,000 panels supporting 50 MW production capacity at Toujounine, on the northern outskirts of the nation's capital.

How can Mauritania transform its energy sector?

This could kickstart the transformation of Mauritania's energy sector, helping to close gaps in access to electricity and deliver strong economic and social benefits to the Mauritanian people. However, much more investment is needed, as is increased cooperation between both domestic and international stakeholders.

Renewable Energy Opportunities for Mauritania finds that the country could deploy these resources at scale to generate low-cost renewable electricity and hydrogen through electrolysis.

Could renewable generation capacity improve Mauritania's mining operations?
