On Friday 27 October, His Majesty the King of the Netherlands performed the official ceremony to start work on the construction of a national hydrogen network in the Netherlands. Today, Dutch Minister for Climate and Energy Rob Jetten announced new plans for the construction of a national transport network for hydrogen.

Will Gasunie develop the hydrogen network in the Netherlands?

Gasunie will develop the hydrogen network in the Netherlands in the coming years, after which it will assume the role of TSO (Transmission System Operator). The vast majority of the national transport network for hydrogen will consist of pipelines that were previously used for natural gas transport.

The national hydrogen network will give all industrial regions access to hydrogen infrastructure and make the Netherlands the hydrogen port of Europe. The network is being built in phases. In the development of the network, existing pipelines will be used for the most part.
