Historically, the low-carbon electricity journey in the Netherlands has seen notable developments. The early 2000s witnessed modest changes in biofuels and nuclear generation, but it was from the mid-2010s onwards that wind and solar began to flourish.

Is the Netherlands a good country for low-carbon electricity?

In 2024, the Netherlands demonstrates a commendable commitment to low-carbon electricity, with more than half of its electricity consumption coming from clean sources. Wind power contributes a substantial portion, just over a quarter, while solar adds almost a fifth to the mix.

What is the main source of electricity in Netherlands?

Natural gas is the dominant fossil source, responsible for over a third of the electricity, while coal provides close to 7%. Is Electricity Growing in Netherlands?

Does the Netherlands have an energy transition?

In this context, the Netherlands has also set in motion an energy transition to fulfil its European and international obligations. According to the Dutch Climate Act, the Netherlands must have an energy system by 2050 with greenhouse gas emissions that are 95% lower than in 1990. How and with what technologies can that goal be achieved?

Why does the Netherlands export renewable electricity?

Export of renewable electricity is also notable in the ADAPT and TRANSFORM scenarios, despite the strong increase in Dutch electricity demand. The available potential for wind and solar energy enables the Netherlands to supply electricity to adjacent electricity markets.

What are the different types of solar energy generation in the Netherlands?

The generated solar energy consists of solar panels, solar meadows, and solar parks. These are also all forms of the solar energy generation in the Netherlands. The amount of energy generated by solar power depends on the intensity of the sun. It varies during the day and depends on cloud coverage.
