What is the Solar System made up of?

Our solar system is made up of the sun and all the amazing objects that travel around it. The universe is filled with billions of star systems. Located inside galaxies, these cosmic arrangements are made up of at least one star and all the objects that travel around it, including planets, dwarf planets, moons, asteroids, comets, and meteoroids.

What is a small body in the Solar System?

Any natural solar system object other than the Sun, a planet, a dwarf planet, or a moon is called a small body; these include asteroids, meteoroids, and comets. Most of the more than one million asteroids, or minor planets, orbit between Mars and Jupiter in a nearly flat ring called the asteroid belt.

Is the Solar System just a group of planets orbiting the Sun?

The solar system is not just a group of planets slowly orbiting the Sun. It is a lively, moving force participating in a cosmic dance of the infinite between space & time. Everything from the orbit of planets to the incredible movement of our entire solar system through the galaxy there is a lot happening out there.

How fast does the Solar System travel?

Relative to the galactic center, our solar system travels at a blistering pace of 514,000 mph (828,000 kph). Despite this tremendous speed, we don't feel it because everything around us (Earth, atmosphere, Moon) moves at the same rate. The solar system doesn't trace a flat and smooth path as it orbits around the galactic center.

Why does the Solar System revolve around the Galactic Center?

The Sun - with its entourage of planets, moons, asteroids and comets -- circles the galactic center. In the same way that the gravity of the Sun holds the planets in orbit, so does the gravity of our galaxy hold our solar system locked to it. The solar system revolves around the galactic center once about every 225-250 million years.
