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Do RV batteries need an inverter?

Your RV batteries need DC electricity. An inverter is a device that will take the DC from your RV battery and turn it into an AC that can be used by your appliances. The inverter will turn the 12-volt power from your battery into 120 volt AC power for your appliances. You need an inverter if you are not connected to shore power at an RV site.

What is an RV inverter?

There is a lot more to know about your RV batteries - this is just the beginning! An inverter is what RVs use to change twelve-volt battery power into 110 volts, so you can run things like your microwave without being plugged into the campsite's power grid. There are two types of inverters and many different sizes.

Can an RV inverter use AC power?

If an electronic device is designed for DC power, it cannot use AC power, and vice versa. This is where your RV converter and inverter come in. An RV converter takes AC power, from a shore power connection, converts it into DC, and lowers the voltage to 12 volts. Once the energy is converted, it's sent directly to your RV's batteries.
