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What is battery overheating?

Battery overheating refers to the condition where the operating temperature of the battery exceeds its designed safe range. Every battery has an optimal working temperature range, and when the temperature exceeds this range, the chemical reactions inside the battery can become unstable, leading to performance degradation and even potential hazards.

How do you know if a battery is overheating?

Common symptoms of battery overheating include: Overheating increases internal pressure, potentially causing the battery casing to swell or deform. Overheated batteries may emit odors or smoke, signaling excessive internal reactions. The battery surface temperature will be significantly higher than its normal operating temperature.

What should I do if a battery overheats?

If a battery overheats, the following actions should be taken: Disconnect the power: If the battery overheats during charging or use, immediately stop using it and disconnect the power source. Cool the battery: Place the battery in a shaded, ventilated area, avoiding exposure to high temperatures.

Can a battery cause heat accumulation?

Even when not in use, internal chemical reactions within a battery can still occur, which may lead to heat accumulation. Specifically, when batteries are stored for long periods, not fully charged or discharged, or stored in hot environments, internal resistance can cause temperature rise.
