

Title: UK Energy Storage by 2025

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How much battery storage capacity will the UK have in 2025?

By early 2025, there will be phenomenal growth in battery storage capacity taking place in the UK: Operational capacity: Around 5 GW of battery storage capacity is operational. Pipeline projects: There is currently an estimated pipeline demand of 127 GW of capacity with proposed developments.

How many battery energy storage applications have been filed in the UK?

More than 100 planning applications for battery energy storage systems were filed in the UK between April and June 2025, covering a combined 8.4GW of capacity. That is more than twice as much as in the same quarter last year.

How much battery storage will Britain need by 2030?

To meet its 95 per cent clean power goal, the government estimates Britain will need about 23-27GW of battery storage by 2030, up from about 6GW now. Over the year to June, applications were submitted for 30GW across 400 schemes. Total capacity of renewable energy planning applications submitted, 4-quarter rolling total, UK (GW)

How much battery storage capacity does the UK have?

The UK's total battery storage project pipeline currently contains a total of 127GW of capacity. Figure 1 demonstrates the amount of capacity at each development stage as a proportion of the total pipeline. 8% of the capacity pipeline in the UK is operational or under construction, with 31% approved and yet to begin construction.

Is the battery storage pipeline growing in the UK?

This report will be launched to coincide with Clean Power Grid Conference 2025, 1 May 2025 at the IET, London. Overall though, the breakdown of the battery storage pipeline in the UK indicates a position of growth, with a large proportion of the pipeline capacity in early development, in planning and consented stages.
