In modern double glazed windows, this air gap slows down heat transfer, both hot and cold, via conduction. It doesn't trap heat, but it slows down its movement so that neither heat nor cold can pass through the window.

What type of glass does a double glazed window use?

Acoustic Glass: Some double glazed windows use acoustic glass, which has a layer of polyvinyl butyral (PVB) laminated between the glass panes. This layer helps dampen sound vibrations, providing superior noise reduction. Condensation Control

What is a double glazing unit?

Double Glazing Units (DGU) consist of two glass panes separated by a hermetically sealed space filled with air or an inert gas like argon. This construction creates a sealed unit, forming a layer of insulation between the glass panes. The space between the panes varies, typically ranging from 6mm to 20mm, depending on specific requirements.
