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What is Uzbekistan's Power Energy Strategy?

Generally, the Uzbekistan's power energy strategy and targets for 2030 can be summarized as follows: proceeding with the unbundling and the de-centralization in the industry, including the reforming of the tariff-setting; furthering privatization in the energy sector by the attraction of private foreign and local direct investments;

How will Uzbekistan improve electricity production?

The government plans to invest \$4 billion in the National Electric Grid of Uzbekistan over the next five years to facilitate these projects. Reducing electricity production costs is another major priority, with a particular emphasis on alternative energy sources.

Does Uzbekistan have a single power grid?

Although private entities are able to engage in the generation of power energy, their access to the Single Power Grid (as the Uzbekistan's country-wide grid is named) requires the obtainment of a special permit.

What is Uzbekistan's energy policy?

As the current energy policy of the Uzbek government signifies, Uzbekistan is going to focus on diversifying its energy resources, developing the renewable energy sector and attracting private investments with foreign companies having a priority.

How much electricity does Uzbekistan need?

According to projections, Uzbekistan will require 117 billion kilowatt-hours of electricity by 2030, increasing to 135 billion kilowatt-hours by 2035--1.7 times the current consumption. To meet these demands, the Ministry of Energy has developed a long-term strategy focused on infrastructure development and efficiency improvements.

How will Uzbekistan support supplementary power?

A crucial aspect of this plan is ensuring that regions facing energy deficits can receive supplementary power from other areas. The government plans to invest \$4 billion in the National Electric Grid of Uzbekistan over the next five years to facilitate these projects.
