Read on to fully prepare for your trip. In Iceland, electrical plugs and outlets adhere to the European standard, characterized by the Type C and Type F sockets.

Do I need a power converter in Iceland?

Iceland uses Northern European electrical standards (50 Hz/220 volts) so converters may be required for small electrical appliances brought from home. Some appliances such as chargers for laptops, digital cameras or mobile phones, may already be compatible with multiple voltages and may just need a travel adapter.

Where can I buy a power adapter in Iceland?

Power adapters and converters are readily available for purchase in various stores across Iceland, including electronics stores and even some hardware stores. The most convenient option, however, is to pick one up at the duty-free in Keflavik Airport upon arrival but keep in mind that they may not have every possible adapter type available.

Where does electricity come from in Iceland?

Electricity in Iceland is predominantly sourced from renewable resources such as hydroelectric and geothermal power. This is thanks to the abundant rivers and waterfalls found around the country and Iceland's location on the Mid-Atlantic Ridge, the source of the island's famous volcanic activity.

What voltage is used in Iceland?

This voltage is compatible with most European appliances and electronics. However, travelers visiting from countries with different voltage standards will require a voltage adapter to safely use their devices.
